6. Quantify initial GHG reductions and costs/savings
7. Fully develop policy option templates
8. Develop alternatives to address barriers as needed
9. Aggregate and integrate results
10. Finalize and report recommendations

## Policy Option Template

- **Policy Description (Concept)**
- **Policy Design (Goals, Timing, Parties Involved)**
- Implementation Methods
- Related Programs and Policies (BAU)
- Estimated GHG Savings and Costs Per MMtCO<sub>2</sub>e
  - Data Sources, Methods and Assumptions
  - Key Uncertainties
- Additional (non-GHG) Benefits and Costs, as Needed
- Feasibility Issues, if Needed
- Status Of Group Approval
- Level of Group Support
- Barriers to Consensus, if any

## Straw Proposal Process

- Policy Description – Brief description of policy option elements. Should not be more than one or two paragraphs in length. May be based on text from the “Brief Description for Catalog Actions” document.
- Policy Design – Quantitative goal in “everyday” language and metrics (i.e., kWh produced, gallons produced, efficiency target, recycling rate), with levels and timing.
